Budget Narrative

Nutrition Education Center \$10,000

Kitchen Remodel

- Flooring
- Appliances
- Furniture
- Shelving
- Locked Storage
- Demonstration Cart

- *Educational programming will also be available at sites outside of the WAFER facility.
- *Supplies will be transported to outreach sites as needed.
- *Programming beyond the grant year will be offered.

Kitchen Equipment \$1,000

- Cooking Demo Tools

- *To include skillet, toaster (convection) oven, hot-top burner, blender, crockpot, utensils, knives, pots and pans, cutting board, mixing bowls, and wood spatulas.

Supplies \$2,500

- *Handout, recipes, placards.
- *Cleaning and sanitizing supplies.

Food \$12,000

- *Food not available from the food pantry will be purchased to ensure thorough education session.

Participant Incentives \$35,000

Such as:

- Crockpots
- Cookware set
- Utensil package
- Farmers Market Vouchers
- Gas card
- Recipe book
- Seeds, pots/soil

- *To encourage participation and regular attendance for the entire session, incentives will be offered. These will vary based on the topic of the session, season, or needs.

- *We are expecting 10-15 participants per topic session.

Staffing

Implementation Coordinator \$10,000

Instruction Costs \$15,000

Garden Coordinator \$2,000

Fiscal Administration \$5,000

Volunteer Educators \$0 (In-Kind)

- *To cover additional duties associated with education.

Facility Charge \$7,500
