



# The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

Household Income Eligibility March 2020 through February 2021

TEFAP Applicants self-declare their income eligibility by determining that combine household income is equal to or less that the amounts shown in the table below. Proof of income is not required to enroll in TEFAP.

| <b>4 persons</b>  | \$4,039                           | \$48,470                           |
| <b>5 persons</b>  | \$4,730                           | \$56,758                           |
| <b>6 persons</b>  | \$5,421                           | \$65,046                           |
| <b>7 persons</b>  | \$6,111                           | \$73,334                           |
| <b>8 persons</b>  | \$6,802                           | \$81,622                           |
| <b>9 persons</b>  | \$7,493                           | \$89,910                           |
| <b>10 persons</b> | \$8,183                           | \$98,198                           |
| <b>11 persons</b> | \$8,874                           | \$106,486                          |
| <b>12 persons</b> | \$9,565                           | \$114,774                          |

To determine eligibility for households of more than 12 members, add \$8,288 per additional person per year; this value equals an additional \$691 per additional person per month.
